The Alberta IOT Association ("AIA") is a not-for-profit consisting of organizations with a vested interest in the success of the Internet of Things in the province of Alberta. Our mission is to position Alberta as the worldwide center of excellence for the Internet of Things technology.

These terms and conditions describe the contract through which the Alberta IOT Association will deliver a service to you as a member. To apply and become accepted as a member of AIA requires that you agree to these terms and conditions.

Joining the AIA as a "member", you are subscribing to a service. The word "member" or "membership" refers to your subscription and your status as a subscriber to the AIA.
